What should I wear?

Some people dress up. Some people dress down. We believe that God doesn't care whether you're in shorts or jeans, a dress or a suit, so neither do we.

What should I expect?

First of all, know that we won't single you out or make you feel uncomfortable. You will be welcomed warmly when you enter. Most people arrive 5-10 minutes early to chat and find a seat.

Once our service starts, we'll Welcome everyone and share Announcements. Then we'll Read some Scripture, Pray and Sing some Songs. After this, the Pastor will Preach from the Bible.

On the first Sunday of the month, we'll share in Communion and then close in Prayer, and we're dismissed. We even have potluck lunches on occasion so you can enjoy longer fellowship times!

How will I know what to do?

We make it easy. There's no assigned seating, so sit anywhere. If we want everybody to stand or sit down, we'll say so. When we read from the Bible, we try to give the page numbers (of the pew Bible so it can be found easily). You're welcome to take a Bible home if you need one.

What about my kids?

We love kids at PCC! They'll learn about God and the Bible through our Children's Message in the Service. They also will enjoy stories, crafts and games in our Sunday School Class for Kids (@ 9 am) and on Wednesday Nights @ 6 pm (September-May) (WOW Program ages 4-grade 6). There's also a Youth Gathering (CYU, grades 7-12) every Wednesday at 6 pm!

During the Worship Service, many families choose to keep their kids with them. We offer kiddie bags with a variety of items for our children to use during the service. Several pews have beautiful Children's Picture Bibles also.

We have a well-equipped Nursery available downstairs for Parents and their Children to use as needed. The Worship Service is streamed on television in this room as well.
